

HOUSE SYSTEM

In order to achieve the primary objectives of Education, ABPS follows a House System, where in all students are uniformly distributed in the following four houses:-

RAVI HOUSE



ARUN HOUSE



BHASKAR HOUSE

Each student is placed in one of the four houses. Each house has a girl and a boy House Captain. A member of the staff acts as a House Master/Mistress. Students are urged to compete with themselves, raising their own excellence bar. Points are awarded to students throughout the year for co-curricular activities through Inter House Competition in sports & games, debates, elocution, quiz, role plays (CCA activities) etc. and trophy/prizes are awarded accordingly. At the end of the academic session, the house gaining the highest point is awarded the running trophy of Best House of the year. The aim of the House System is to inculcate and develop the qualities of leadership, public speaking, organization skill amongst the students through various inter house competitions and help the students to strike a fine balance between competition and collaboration.
